

The supplies listed below should be in an airlock in front of the gate of the quarantine area. Only designated staff should enter the area or interact with the quarantined horse, according to the quarantine level designation.

Quarantine supplies include:

- Barrier clothing (long-sleeved shirts, scrub bottoms or coveralls): should be worn over clothes whenever entering the quarantine enclosure
- Latex gloves
- Boot covers
- Dilute bleach spray* (keep out of direct sunlight)
- Dedicated feed and water bins
- Dedicated muck cart or bucket
- Dedicated muck fork
- Dedicated halter and lead rope
- Garbage can
- Garbage bags
- Receptacle for used barrier clothing
- Quarantine signs posted around perimeter of enclosure

*1:10 dilute bleach spray = 1 part bleach to 10 parts water

Horse Haven Quarantine Protocols

- All staff and volunteers should follow the quarantine level protocols as posted by the veterinarian.
- All new horse(s) arriving at Horse Haven will go into quarantine for two weeks, or until released by the staff veterinarian.
- If more than one horse arrives from the same place, they can live together during their quarantine period.
- Quarantine areas will be set up a minimum of 35 feet from any current residents, and no nose-to-nose contact will be allowed between the quarantined horse(s) or any others.
- In a red-level quarantine, the quarantine area should be a minimum of 70 feet from any other resident.
