The Homes for Horses Coalition Offers Free Webinar to Help Equine Welfare Organizations Speak-Up for Horses

Lobbying and Political Activity for Horse Rescues will be offered on February, 24 at 1pm ET. This webinar will be presented by two distinguished experts on the subject who have spent their careers speaking-up for animals. Beverly Jones is a Senior Vice President and the Chief Legal Officer for the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, ASPCA® and Keith Dane is the Senior Adviser to Equine Protection of The Humane Society of the United States, The HSUS.

Members of the equine welfare community are in a unique position to understand and make change for horses, whether on national issues such as slaughter and soring or on state and local legislation. “We have the right and responsibility to speak for those who can't. The equines we steward need us to be vehicles of change on their behalf. We have the power to make the change, but there are rules for nonprofits and we need to know the rules to be effective without jeopardizing 501(C)3 status,” said Cindy Gendron, Manager of the Coalition. This webinar will give insight into the difference between lobbying and political activity and inspire organizations to step-out, speak-up and effect change for equines.
